This research is motivated by the problems faced by Akidah Akhlak teachers, namely limited access to technology, not all students have supporting devices such as smartphones or laptops, and unstable internet access, which hinders the use of Wordwall media in learning. In addition, students' interest in learning Akidah Akhlak subjects is still relatively low because many students consider that Wordwall media has been applied to the learning process and has not been fully able to increase their enthusiasm for learning, then not all students are accustomed to digital-based learning, this causes some students to be more comfortable with traditional learning methods compared to using technology.

This research is a qualitative research that uses field research and data collection using observation, interview and documentation methods. Then the analysis technique through data reduction, data presentation and drawing conclusions. The informants in this study were the Akidah Akhlak teachers at the Syekh Ibrahim Kumpulan Islamic Boarding School.

The results of the study can be concluded that the application of wordwall learning media in the subject of Aqidah Akhlak at the Syekh Ibrahim Kumpulan Islamic Boarding School, namely: (1) the application of Wordwall learning media in the subject of Aqidah Akhlak in class VIII of the Syekh Ibrahim Kumpulan Islamic Boarding School includes providing clear explanations, setting time and limits, supervising and reinforcing the material. (2) obstacles in the application of Wordwall learning media in class VIII of the Syekh Ibrahim Kumpulan Islamic Boarding School include limited devices and internet access, limited learning time.
